A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to employment; to restrict public employer
 requests for criminal history information from an
 applicant for employment.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>(1) A public employer shall not ask an</u>
2	applicant for employment to disclose, orally or in writing,
3	information concerning the applicant's criminal record or history,
4	including any inquiry on any employment application, until the public
5	employer has determined the applicant meets the minimum employment
б	qualifications.
7	(2) This section does not apply to any law enforcement
8	agency as defined by section 81-1401, to any position for which a
9	public employer is required by federal or state law to conduct a
10	criminal history record check, or to any position for which federal
11	or state law specifically disqualifies an applicant with a criminal
12	background.
13	(3) This section does not prevent a public employer from
14	conducting a criminal history record check after the public employer
15	has determined that the applicant meets the minimum employment
16	<u>qualifications.</u>
17	(4) For purposes of this section, public employer means
18	the State of Nebraska or any political or governmental subdivision of
19	the State of Nebraska.
